***Framing:** Chemers will be happy to assist in framing your work; if you choose to frame it yourself, please bring your frame for approval, prior to submission. Oils, acrylics & mixed media can be unframed if gallery wrapped edges are painted. All other two-dimensional work must be framed and ready to hang. Simple frames are preferred, acceptable colors: black, gold & any dark wood. Mats: neutral white, acid free (like Bainbridge 8655), colored filets ok, and either double 4 plys or single 6 or 8 ply mats. No non-glare glass. Space and weight limits apply to non two-dimensional work, see Karen Raab.
